- 2001: Center established in 2001
- 2001 – 04: Survey item development and revisions
- 2004: Benchmarks created
- 2006: Special focus items to address issues of current importance and local interest
- 2010: Online reporting system

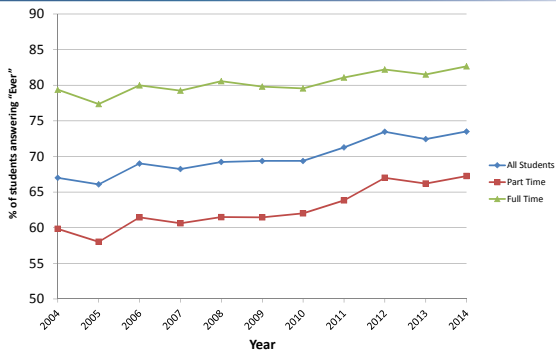
Overview of Methods

- All students completing CCSSE survey between 2004 and 2014: **1,887,781**
- Oversample respondents and all other students meeting standard exclusionary criteria excluded.
- Recoded variables to dichotomous variables:
 - **Never** versus **Ever** (Sometimes/Often/Very Often)
 - **Very Little/Some** versus **Quite a Bit/Very Much**
- We looked at percentage point change in responses over time
- For each year, we present only data from students who completed survey that year
 - All Students
 - Part-Time/Full-Time
 - Non-Developmental/Developmental
- Weight values from year of response were used

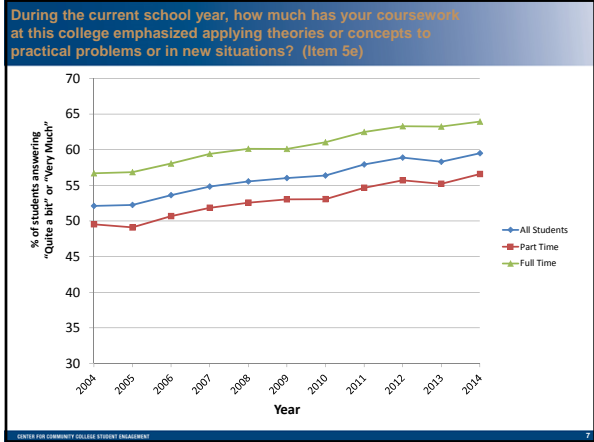

During the current school year, about how often have you made a class presentation? (Item 4b)

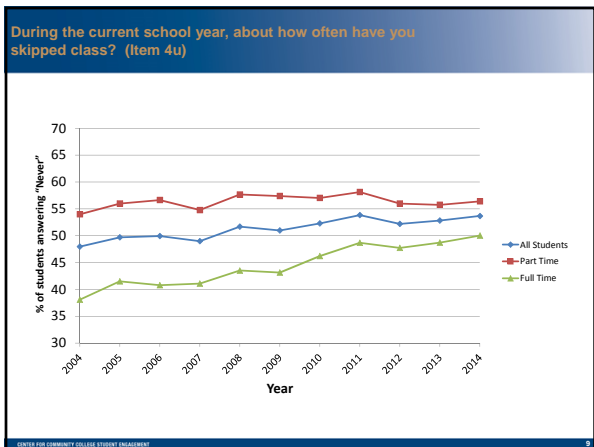

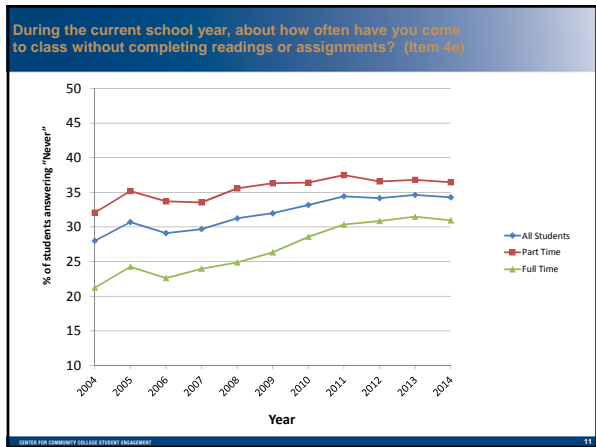


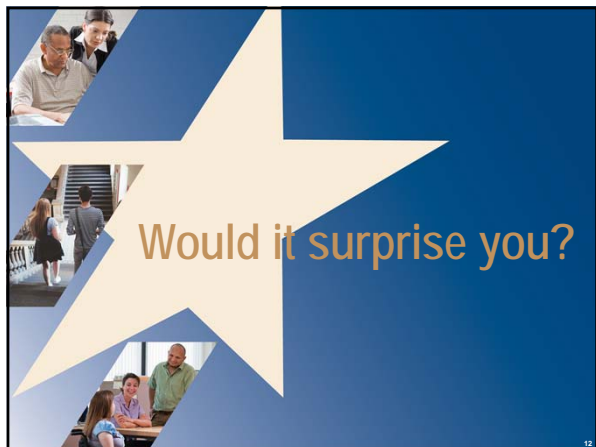
In your experiences at this college during the current school year, about how often have you skipped class?

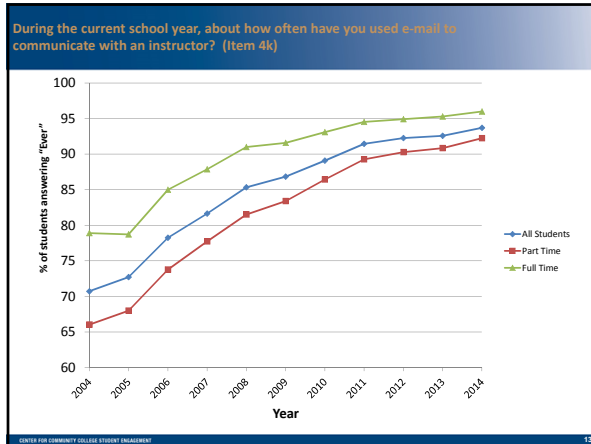

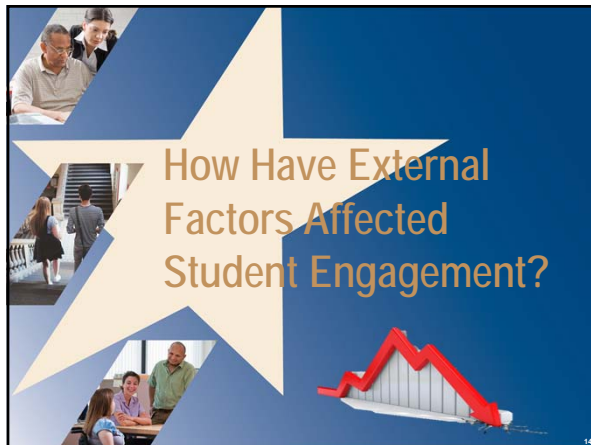


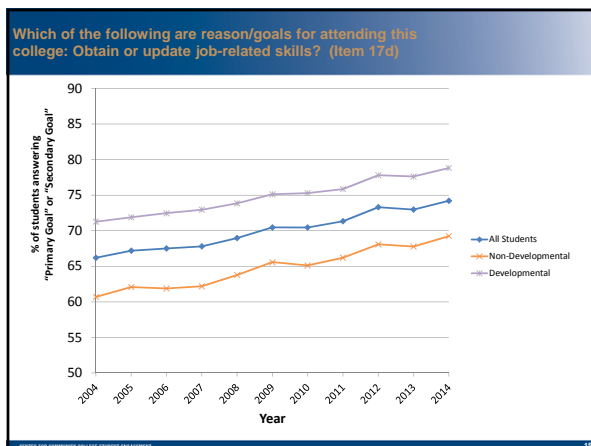
During the current school year, about how often have you come to class without completing readings or assignments?

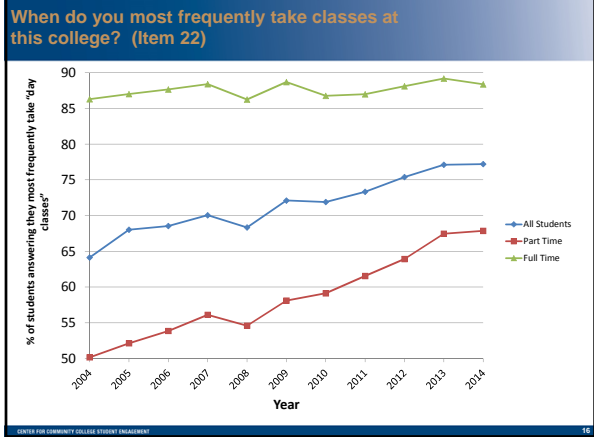


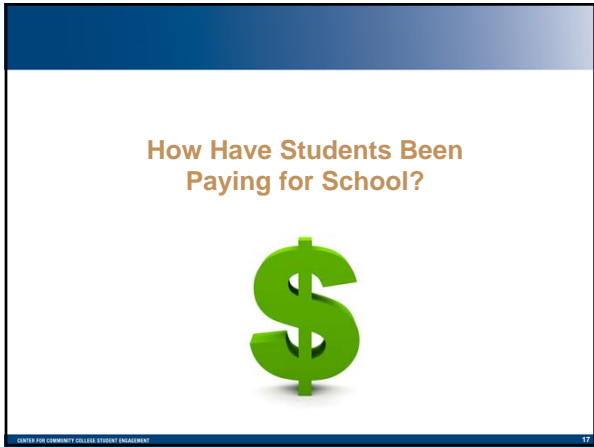


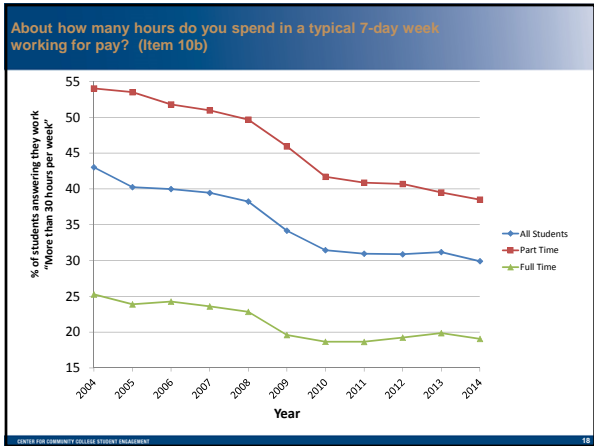










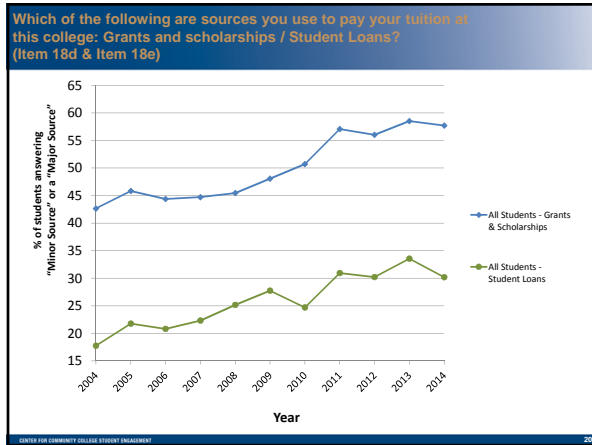


Which of the following are sources you use to pay your tuition at this college: Grants and scholarships / Student Loans?

Summary


- Overall, levels of engagement are holding steady or trending in a positive direction!
