Milestones 1 - 3

College Readiness

Complete math DE = 1 point Complete reading DE = .5 point Complete writing DE = .5 point

First College-Level Course

Pass 1st college math course = 1 point Pass 1st college reading course = .5 point Pass 1st college writing course = .5 point



Milestones 4 & 5

Progress to Credential Complete 15 semester credit hours = 1 point **Complete 30 semester** credit hours = 1 point



Milestones 6 - 8

Credentials Awarded

Degree \Certificate Awarded = 2 points Critical Field = 2.25

Transfer Transfer to university after completing 15 semester credit hours = 2 points
