- Easy to read, access and interpret
 - Concise one point access
- Visual Analytics
 - Visually analyze data to identify Trends and Patterns
- Key Performance Indicators
 - Enrollment data
 - Persistence data
 - Graduation data
 - Employment data

Best Practices

- Identify key metrics that matter to your institution
- Cleanse your data.
- Keep it simple and visual.
- Make it Interactive.
- Five to ten years of data for longitudinal analysis.
- Easy to use and access.

Tableau Public (Free)

- Support for data sets of up to 10 million rows
- An increased storage limit of 10 GB
- The ability to limit the downloading of files from Tableau Public








Tableau Server - Administration














