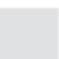

87th TEXAS LEGISLATURE, REGULAR SESSION (2021)

HB 3767 RELATING TO MEASURES TO SUPPORT WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT IN THE STATE, INCLUDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TRI-AGENCY WORKFORCE INITIATIVE AND ADDITIONAL EMPLOYER WORKFORCE DATA REPORTING

[The] TEA and THECB are directed to make available to each public school and institution of higher education student outcome information, including credential completion, employment status and industry of employment, and earnings over time [contingent upon federal funding].

TWC Confidential Wage Data

1. Develop a rock-solid case why publicly available data are not enough and why you can't wait for the data that is being developed under HB 3767.
2. Submit a TWC Data Exchange Request and Safeguard Plan
 1. Form does not seem to be available online.
 2. Most fields are routine.
 3. Cost is \$250 to \$1,000 per year
 4. Question 20: "TWC data at rest will be stored in a secure location on local drive using BitLocker with FIPS 140-2 encryption."

TWC Review Process

- The TWC has a committee that reviews data requests.
- The committee is led by Nicholas Lealos, Open Records Manager & Assistant General Counsel
- The committee includes Christopher Murphy, Contract Manager in the Contract Administration Department
- Lee College submitted the data request on 6/12/2020. Our contract was approved on 6/24/2022.

TWC Technical Set-Up: GoAnywhere

- Public PGP Key to encrypt the data
- IP Address range, e.g. 68.232.208.0 - 68.232.223.255 68.232.208.0/20
- Distribution email addresses for a technical contact and business contact, e.g., IT@lee.edu & BusinessOffice@lee.edu (not tom.davis@lee.edu)
- TWC will issue GoAnywhere user ID. Follow the process to generate your password.

TWC Data Submission

- Submission File: a “csv” with only one field: SSN.
- Does not need to be encrypted.
- No header row

TWC Data Output

- Line 1: SSN
- Line 2: Name, TWCEIN, NAICS, Address, Phone, Wages, Quarter

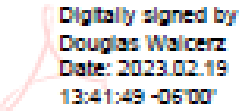


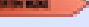

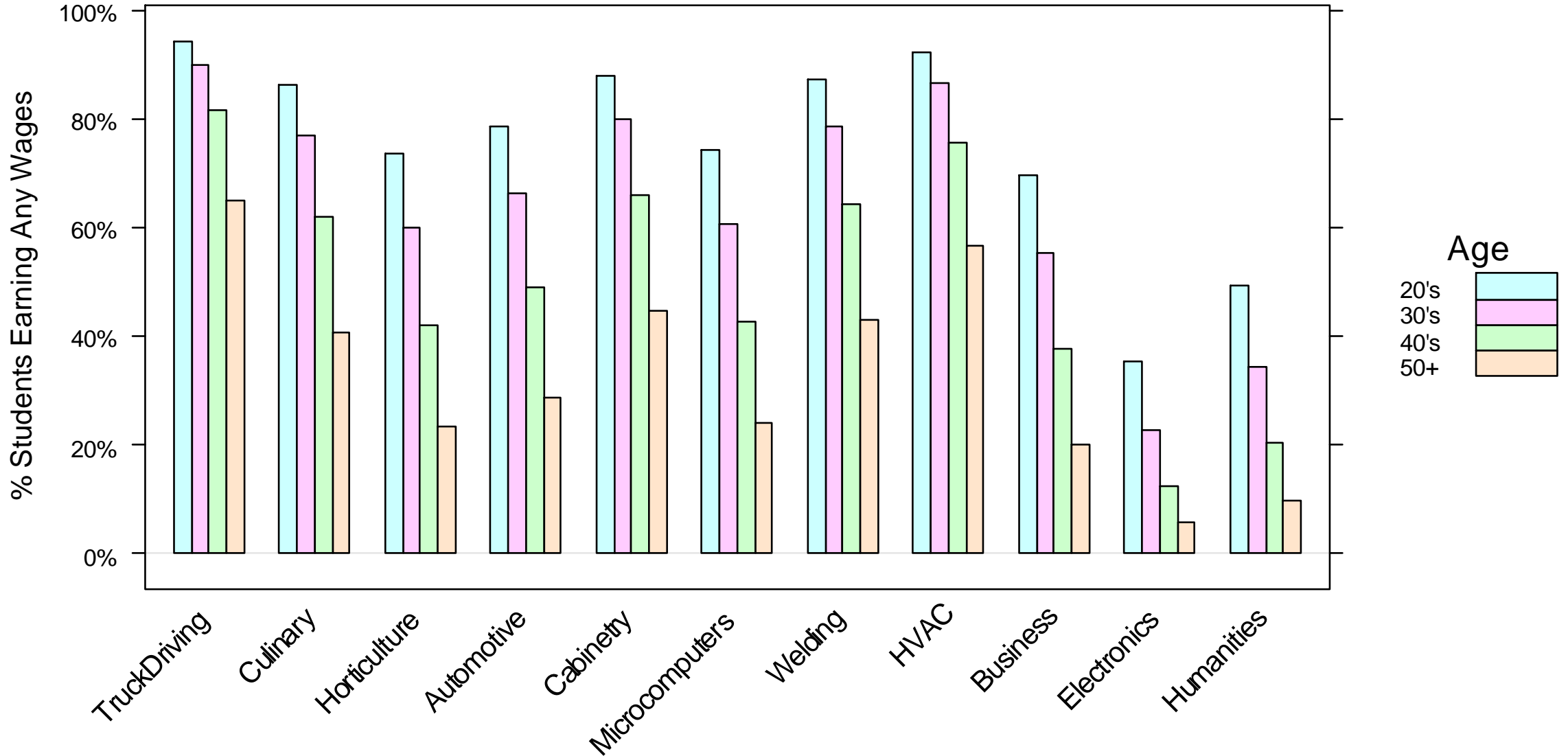
Lee College System for Auditing Compliance with 20 C.F.R. § 603.9

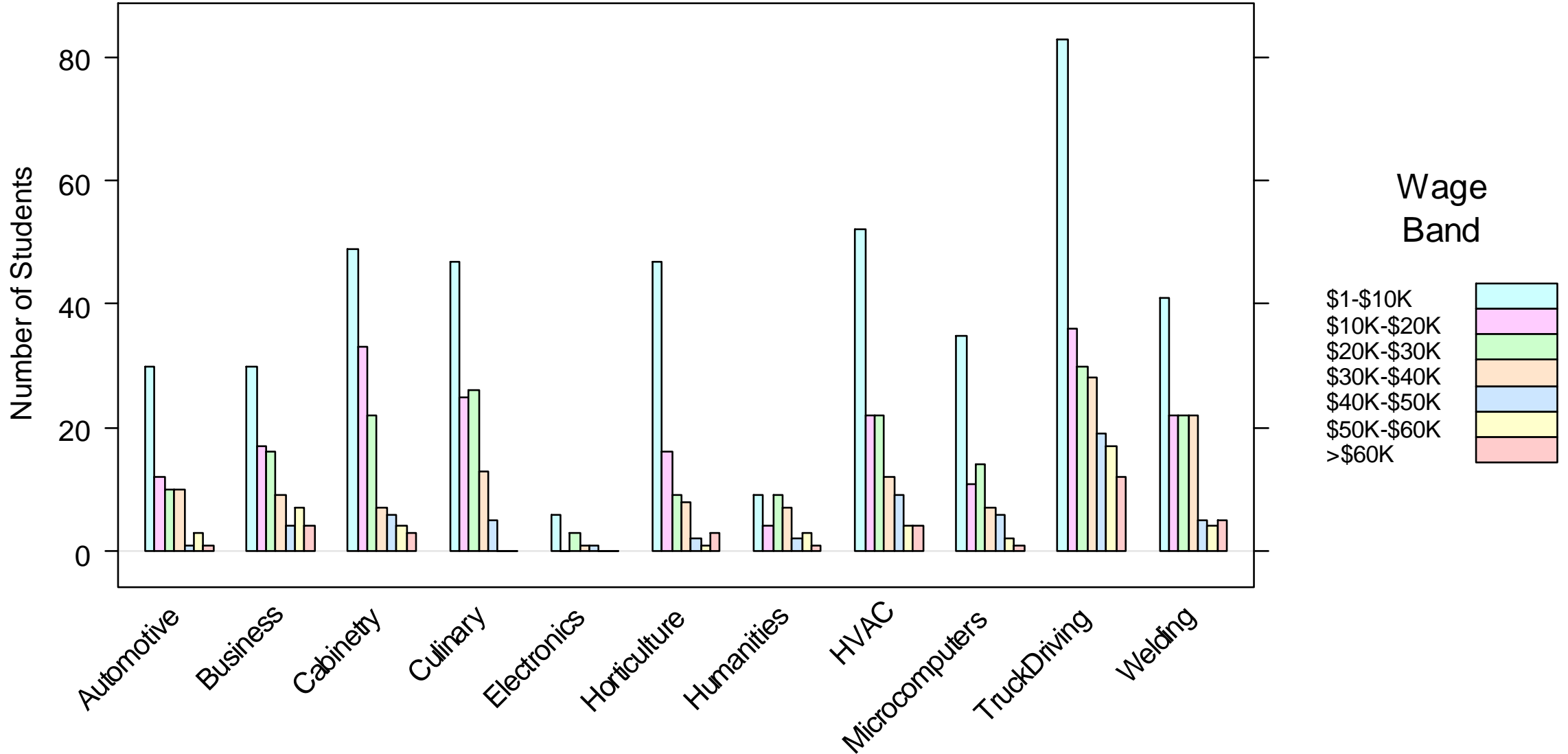

Limitations of TWC Data

- Does not include people who are self-employed
- Does not include people working as independent contractors (1099s)
- Does not include employees paid in cash (under the table)
- Examples:
 - Cosmetology graduates who lease a “chair” at a salon
 - Truck drivers who are owner-operators
 - Plumbers, electricians, carpenters, HVAC repairpersons, etc. who run their own one-person businesses

TAIR Community Research Request?

- Establish a TAIR committee on labor market outcomes and develop a research proposal in collaboration with the UH-ERC to provide data for all TAIR participating members.
- Loop in the THECB and ask them to produce the standard reports as a response to HB 3767.
