FUNDING POTENTIAL: DUAL CREDIT 15 SCH ATTAINMENT

1. Identify Free and Swift Transfer (FAST) participants and their high school.
2. Project Semester Credit Hours of Completion at the close of the school year.
3. Estimate the number of students who will attain 15 SCH or more in the current academic year.
4. Utilize these data for CTE and Academic pathways and for the finance of the College.
5. Encourage dual credit participants to attain a Certification or two-year credential.

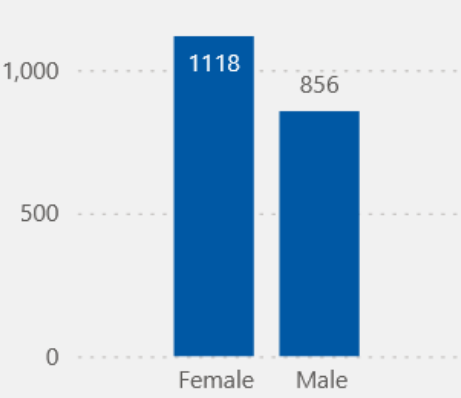


Hours Earned by Dual Credit Students in 2022-2023

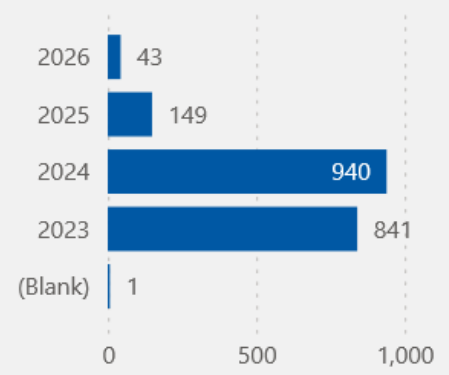

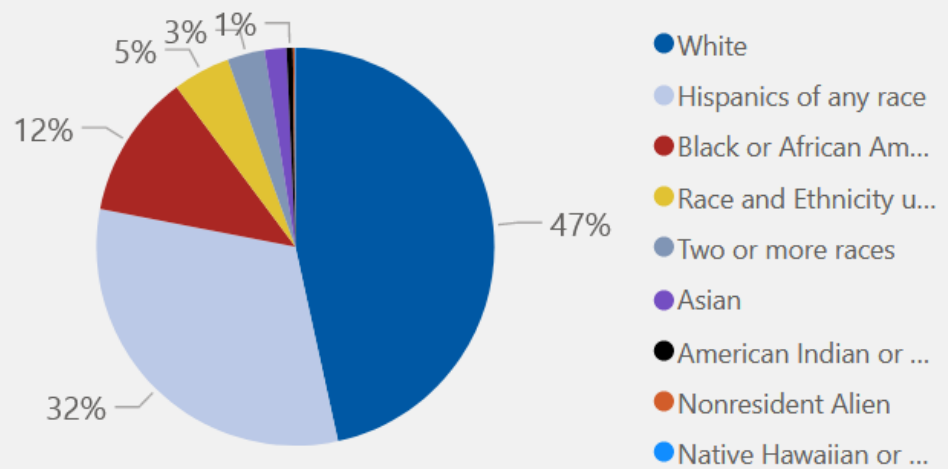

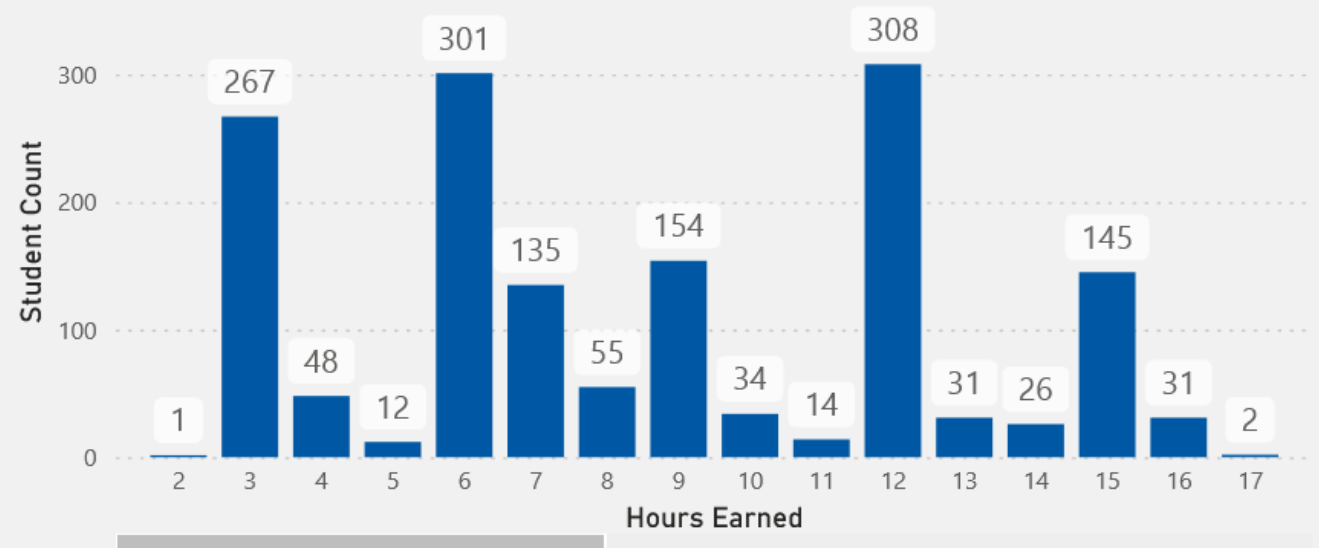

Career Hours Earned



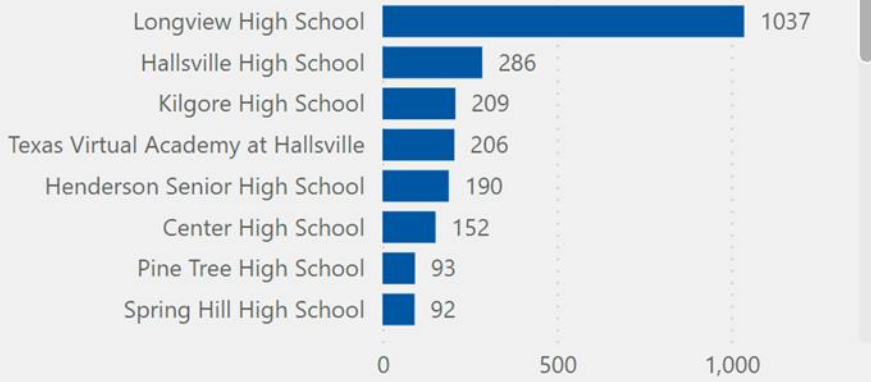

Transfer Status of Students Enrolled in 21-22

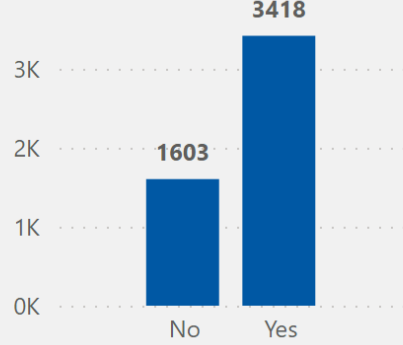

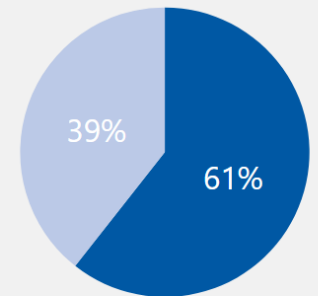

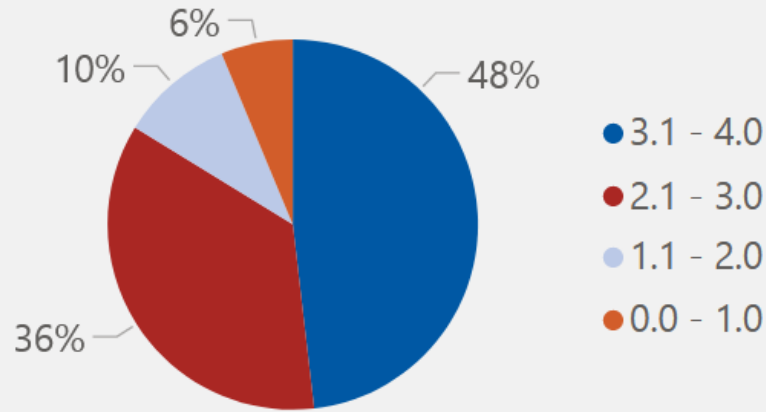

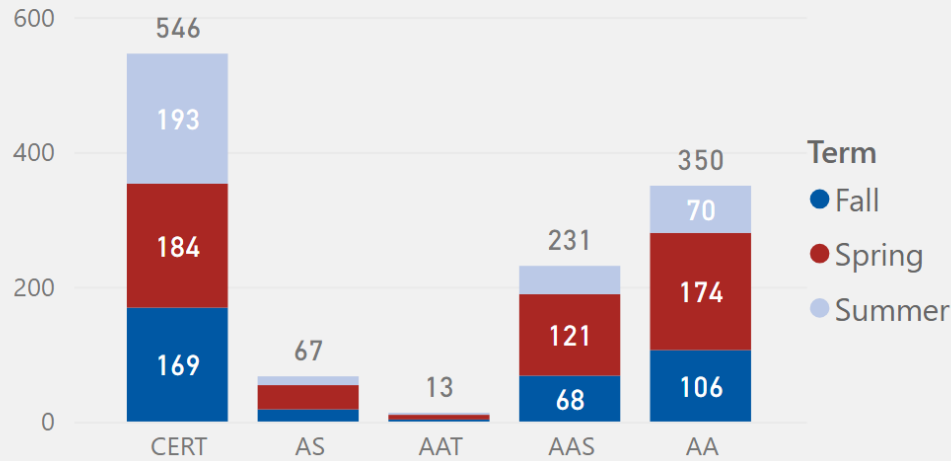

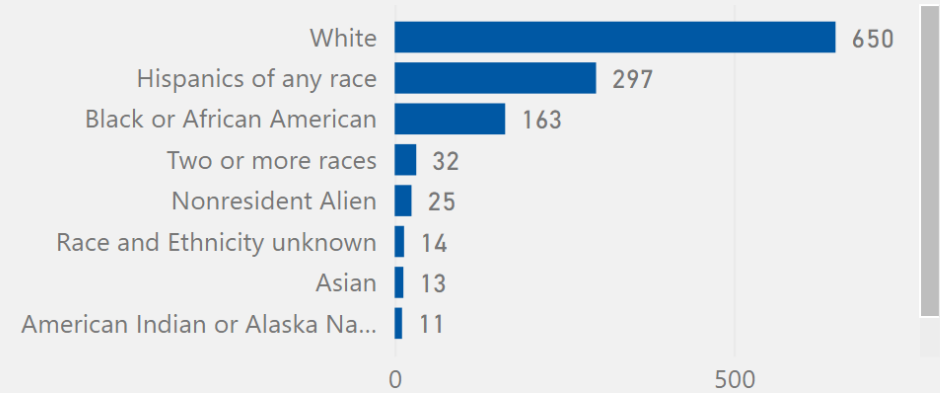

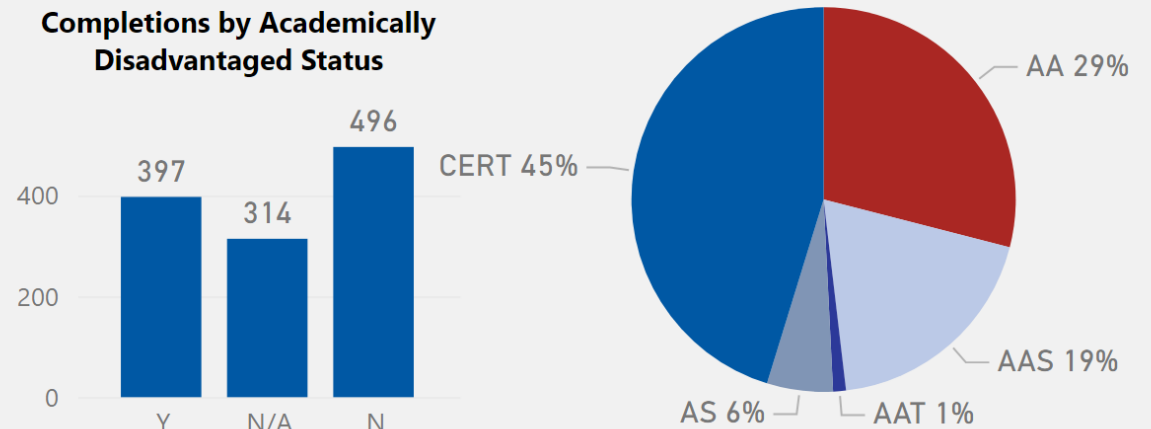
Completions by Degree and Term



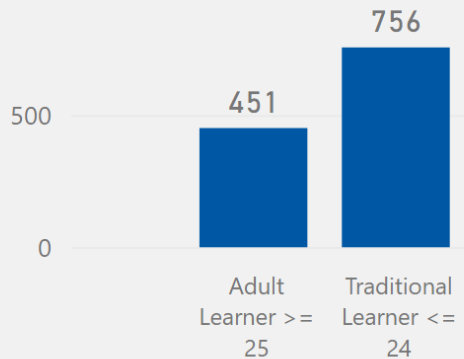
Completions by Race/Ethnicity



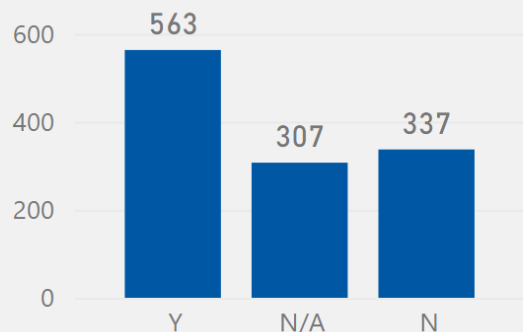
Distribution of Completions by Degree



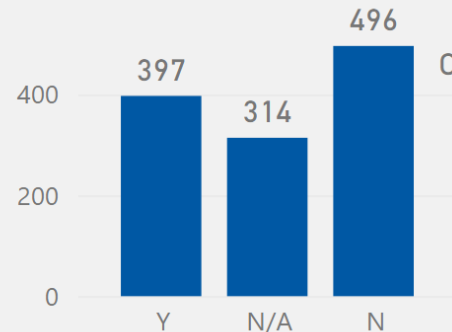
Completions by Age Group

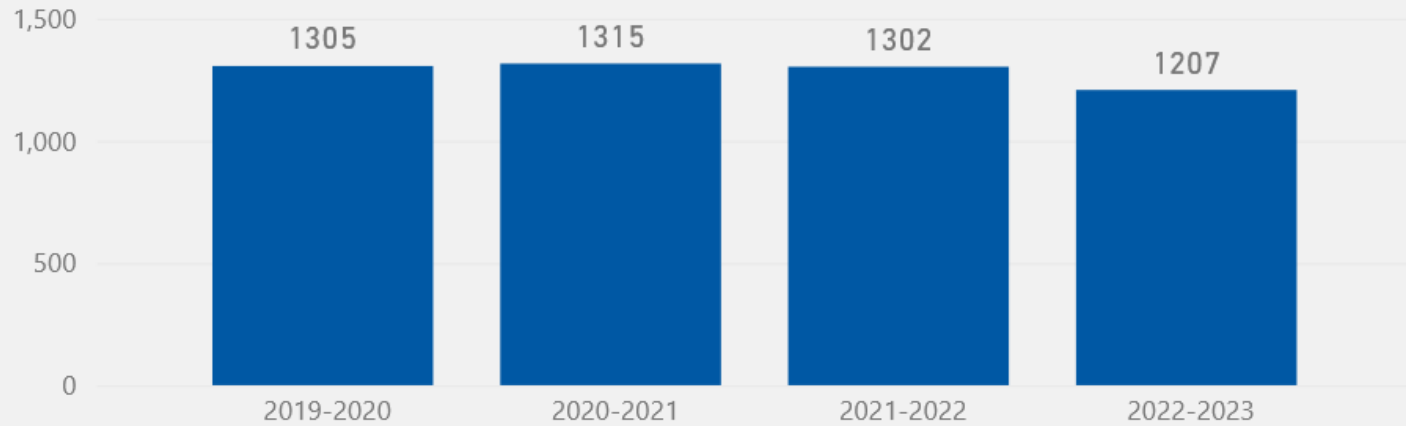

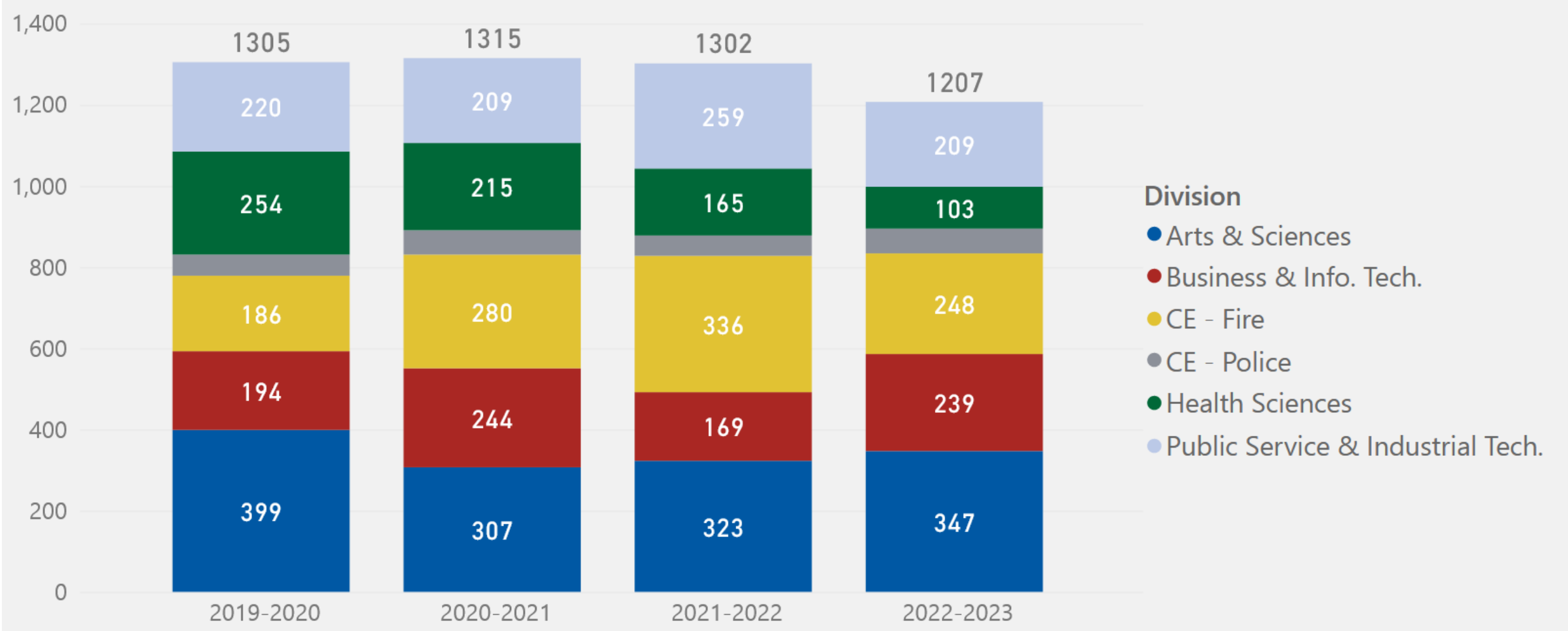
Academically Disadvantaged Awards by Year
