Credit for Prior Learning

What is typically considered Credit for Prior Learning?

Any education or credit outside a traditional academic environment.

- Exams
- Portfolio or other individualized assessment
- Evaluation of noncollege and noncredit programs
- Advanced Placement and Dual Credit

Credit for Prior Learning

What is UTSA considers Credit for Prior Learning?

- ***Credit by Competency***: CPL credit awarded for IS 1403, IS 1413, and competency exams.
- ***Credit by Exam***: CPL credit awarded for passing national examinations, such as the College Level Examination Program (CLEP).
- ***Military Credit***: CPL credit awarded for military experience or training obtained at institutions like the Defense Language Institute or Air University, as well as through DANTES.
- ***Other***: CPL credit awarded for reasons not specified above.

Leadership Challenges & Student Benefits

Texas Legislature: Reduce Time and Cost to Degree

Some of the measures the Texas legislature mandates

- Texas Administrative Code 22 TAC § 221.3 – recognize CPL for Advanced Practice Registered Nurse licensure
- Texas House Bill C.S.H.B. 269 mandates the award of course credit for military service
- Texas Education Code 51.968 requires institutions to award credit for prior learning through standardized exams, including the College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

University Leadership: Reduce Time and Cost to Degree

UT San Antonio's Goals

- **Broaden CPL offerings** as part of a university-wide credential expansion effort.
- **Align CPL pathways with workforce and market needs**, ensuring that students can leverage industry-recognized skills.
- **Create more flexible, accessible pathways that shorten time to degree**, particularly for working adults.
- **Improve career outcomes** by recognizing competencies students already possess.
- **Track impact** by analyzing CPL on Student, Awarded Degree, Student College, and College of Instruction.

Where and How to get the Data

Banner and Friends

- **Explore** Registrar's Banner Tables indicating any credit awarded not by a UTSA class.
- **Verify** with UTSA's Assessment Center and the Registrar's Office what each credit type is and where it comes from.
- **Flag Errors** so they can be fixed: Often, data that is not used frequently and requires manual entry will have erroneous records.

The tables used are SHRTRCR, SHRTRIT, STVSBGI, SHRTRCE, SHRTRAM, SHRGRDE, SHRDGMR, IR_DEPT_COLL (x-walk), SORFOLK, SPBPERS, and GORPRAC

The Dashboard Process

Data delivery! Where do you want me to put it?

- ***Meet*** with stakeholders so that the categories are useful to gain insight.
- ***Get feedback*** from the IR Team and stakeholders.
- ***Build*** the dashboard.
- ***Rinse, repeat until well done!***



SCH by College of Instruction


● Credit by Competency ● Credit by Exam ● Military Credit ● Other

Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) shown here by the college of the student's primary major at the time CPL was earned. See methodology for details.






